RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECT

Under the provisions of GDPR, you have the following rights as the data subject:

- right of access to data;
- right to rectification of data;
- right to erasure of data ('right to be forgotten');
- right to restriction of data processing;
- right to data portability;
- right to object (where the controller's legitimate interest is the basis for data processing);
- right to withdraw consent (where consent is the basis for data processing).

The exercise of these rights is subject to the conditions set out in GDPR. If your request is rejected, you will receive a reply with relevant reason for such decision.

PROTECTION

We use a range of physical, electronic and managerial measures to ensure that we keep your personal information secure, accurate and up to date. These measures include:

- education and training to relevant staff to ensure they are aware of our privacy obligations when handling personal information
- administrative and technical controls to restrict access to personal information on a 'need to know' basis
- technological security measures, including firewalls, encryption and anti-virus software
- physical security measures, such as staff security passes to access our premises.

Although we use appropriate security measures once we have received your personal information, the transmission of data over the internet (including by e-mail) is never completely secure. We endeavor to protect personal information, but we cannot guarantee the security of data transmitted to us or by us.

PERIOD OF DATA PROCESSING

We will hold your personal information on our systems for the longest of the following periods: (i) as long as is necessary for the relevant activity or services; (ii) any retention period that is required by law; (iii) the end of the period in which litigation or investigations might arise in respect of the services.
